Any accretions hereto and income thereof shall be applied in perpetuity for the objects and purposes hereinafter set out.

- d) The Trust shall not participate or intervene or interfere in any political campaign or activity on behalf of or for any candidate or party or otherwise in any manner.

1. Name

The Trust, hereby created, shall be designated "OSHO SIDDHARTH FOUNDATION".

2. Registered Office of Trust

The Registered Office of the Trust shall be situated in the National Capital Territory of Delhi at such location(s) as the Trustees may, from time to time, determine. Presently, such office shall be located at L-125, Sector-2, DSIDC, Bawana, Delhi - 110 039.

3. Main Objects

The Trustees shall hold the Trust fund and its income upon Trust to apply them for the following objects:-

A. EDUCATION

- 1. Publication of different monthly, fortnightly and yearly magazines and writing and publication of books on nationalism, spiritualism, Yoga, Naturopathy Homeopathy, Ayurveda and arrangement of publication, reprinting, original writing, compilation and to spread these Vedic ancient treatise among the general public. To establish a printing press.
- 2. To organize personality development camps, exhibition, country wide travel, anniversaries of great people and different programmes for students and teachers to instill human values, moral upliftment and patriotism.
- 3. Character building, moral upliftment and knowledge of culture ,awakening of national pride, equitable society, arrangement of study and teaching of Veda, Geeta, philosophy, Upanishad, grammar for the welfare of world .To provide daily, weekly, fortnightly, monthly, Quarterly and Yearly training to the students

- To begin diploma, degree and master courses for students in disciplines of Yoga, Naturopathy, Meditation, Homeopathy, Ayurveda & Other Alternative Medicines Systems.
- 5. Establishment and / or acquisition and maintenance of Schools, (residential/nonresidential / day cum boarding) Colleges, cultural and other Educational Institutions for the diffusion of useful knowledge, right ideas and training imparting education and training of students in such lines or courses as the Trustees may, from time to time, deem fit.
- Declaration of prizes for schools, colleges or other educational institutions.
- 7. Establishment and maintenance of hostels and / or boarding houses and grants of free boarding and lodging to poor and deserving students studying in any schools, colleges and educational institutions or receiving education or training and upon such terms and for such period in each case as the Trustees may deem fit.
- 8. Grant monetary assistance including Scholarships, stipends for creative and cultural activities and / or loans to poor students whom the Trustees may deem to be deserving thereof to enable them to receive such education, vocational, industrial, commercial technical, scientific, physical, sociological journalistic and arts and crafts and upon such terms and for such period in each case as the Trustees may deem fit.
- Supply of books, magazine, journals, stationary, computers, equipments and any other articles to schools or colleges and to open libraries, food and clothes to poor students or grant of monetary assistance to them for such purpose.

- 12. To establish Career guidance bureaus for the students.
- 13. To establish Holistic University for research on Alternative Medicines and Spiritualism.
- 14. To telecast the programs of the trust on Television through Cable/ Dish or any media channel. As well as run a trust owned TV Channel to spread the knowledge.
- 15. To provide academic, professional & vocational education of all kinds as recognized by law with or / and without aid / grant of government.

B. HEALTH & MEDICAL

- To make a disease free world through a scientific approach to Yoga, Naturopathy, Homeopathy, Ayurveda & Other Alternative Medicines systems.
- To form a new integrated system of treatment, consisting mainly of the techniques of Yoga, Naturopathy and Ayurveda, for Surgery and Emergency cases, Allopathy, Homeopathy, Unani and Acupressure to soothe patients suffering from unbearable pains and rid them of disease.
- To prepare and to sale and purchase Ayurvedic medicines & Food products.

- Organizing and advertising the Yoga Meditation, Naturopathy, Homeopathy, Ayurveda Camps, Workshops, Seminars and meetings throughout the world. To build a healthy world through indigenous food, pure food, herbs.

To promote completely modern research centre and treatment facilities for all curable and incurable diseases, solution of mental diseases, naturopathy, Homeopathy, Acupressure and Ayurveda etc. based on ancient art so that the distressed human society will get maximum pleasure from the treatment.
- 6. To grow different kinds of herbal medicines through preservation of different categories of species. Conservation, preservation, and different kind of medicinal gardens for it. 4. OTHER OBJECTS

A. RELIEF OF THE POOR

- To provide and distribute free medicine, clothes food items etc to helpless, poor, downtrodden and underprivileged people and tribal areas. To open special medical camps and hospitals equipped with modern medical facilities.
- To help people in relief works during flood, earthquake, starvation etc. And to provide complete medicinal facilities and monetary resources free of cost for the development of infrastructure.
- To provide food clothes, education and hostel facilities and organization of educational centers for the poor, helpless and underprivileged student's. To provide scholarship to eligible and poor students so that they can be encouraged to grow.
- Establishment, maintenance or support of Sanatoriums, Sheds, Dharamshalas and Orphanages.
- Relief by means of pecuniary or other help in shape of monthly or other periods allowance or allowances or otherwise to such person who may be in strained circumstances or otherwise unable to maintain themselves and may be deserving in support.
- To give relief and help to the needy, blind, lame, deaf and dumb, orphans, widows, aged and other persons disabled or incapable of

5. OBJECTS INCIDENTAL TO MAIN OBJECTS

(i) Arrangements With Governments and Other Bodies

To enter into any arrangement with the Central Government of India or any State Government or any Municipality or Corporation or a Body Corporate or any such authority, local or otherwise that may seem conducive to the fulfillment of the objects of the Trust or any of them and to obtain from any such Government or authority rights, concessions and privileges for the purposes of the objects of the Trust.

(ii) Registration Under Various Laws

To get the trust registered under Income Tax Act, 1961 and or any other law for any matter at any time.

(iii) Libraries

To establish and maintain research reference libraries documentation centers, achieves in pursuance of its objects with reading and writing rooms and other publications and other facilities like audio-visual, sound, video, cinematographic facilities as may be required.

(iv) Seminars

To convene, organize and sponsor conferences, congresses, colloquia, working group, lectures, courses, study-trips, training programs and seminars at such places and at such times as may be determined to promote the objects of the Trust.

(v) <u>Investments</u>

To invest and deal with funds and moneys of the Trust consistent with the activities and requirements of the Trust and as permissible in law particularly under the Income-Tax Act and/or Income Tax Rules or any

other applicable legislation for the time being in force and to vary, alter or to transpose or sell /recall such investments from time to time.

(vi) Bank Accounts

To open and operate bank accounts and to draw, make, accept, endorse, discount, negotiate, execute and other negotiable or transferable instruments or securities.

(vii) Employees

To employ officers and other employees as may be required for the purpose of the Trust and to establish and support or aid in the establishment and support of associations, centers, funds, trusts and conveniences calculated to benefit employees of the Trust or the dependents or connections of such persons and to grant pensions and allowances to and make payments towards insurance and retirement benefits of such persons.

(viii) Professionals

To appoint, employ and retain consultants, Managers, Advisors, Attorneys, Solicitors, Advocates, Accountants, Auditors and other professionals for all or any of the purpose of the Trust.

(ix) Legal Proceedings

To institute, conduct, depend or compromises legal proceedings by or against the Trustees, the Trust or its Officers or employees in respect of any matters affecting it directly or indirectly.

(x) Expenditure

To put out of the funds of the Trust expenses for carrying out any of the foregoing objects including payments of salaries and payments to persons employed.

(xi) Disposal of Properties

Subject to any special consent required by any law, to sell, lease, transfer or otherwise dispose of all or any part of the property assets and investments comprised in the Trust-Deed.

(xii) Raising Funds

To raise funds for the objects of the Trust by accepting donations, fees, contributions or by public subscriptions for specific purposes or otherwise and / or to carry on any allied activity for this purposes in accordance with law.

(xiii) Borrowings

Subject to any consents required by law to borrow money and to charge the whole or any part of the Trust fund with repayment of the money so borrowed.

(xiv) General

Generally to do all such other lawful acts, deeds, or things as may be necessary, helpful conducive or incidental to the attainment and furtherance of any of the above objects and for the growth of the Trust or its resources.

6. ALLIED FUNCTIONS BY TRUSTEES

In the furtherance of the objects set forth above in clauses 3 & 4 but not further or otherwise the Trustees shall have the following powers:

(i) Revenue

To raise funds and invite and receive contributions provided that in raising funds the Trustees shall not undertake any substantial permanent trading or commercial activity and shall confirm to any relevant statutory regulations.

(ii) Acquisition of Properties and Assets

To buy, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise, acquire any property and assets necessary for the achievement of the objects and to maintain and equip it for use.

(iii) Co-operation with Other Charitable Organization

To co-operate with other charities, voluntary bodies and statutory authorities operating in furtherance of the object or of similar Charitable purposes and to exchange information and advice with them.

(iv) Establishment and Membership of Other Institutions

- (a) To establish, promote, co-operate with, become a member of, act as or appoint trustee(s),managers, agent(s) or delegate(s) to conduct, manage, superintend, afford financial assistance to or otherwise assist in any work of any trust, agency, association or institution or anybody having objects similar to those of the Trust.
- (b) To establish missions and branches to achieve the purpose of the Trust.
- (c) To act severally or jointly with any other similarly body or person to achieve the purpose of Trust.

7. NO PROFIT / REMUNERATION TO ANY TRUSTEE

- (i) The income and property of the Trust whatsoever and wherever, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of its objects as set forth hereinabove.
- (ii) No portion of the income or property aforesaid shall be paid, transferred, or distributed directly or indirectly, by way of profit, dividend or otherwise to any one and in particular to any person or persons, who at any time, are or have been the Trustees, or

8. MANAGEMENT

(A) Board of Trustees

- (i) The management and control of the Trust and Trust Properties shall vest in the Board of Trustees (hereinafter referred to as "The Board").
- (ii) The Board will have 3 (three) kinds of Trustees:
 - (a) Regular Trustees
 - (b) Additional Trustees
 - (c) Alternate Trustee
- (iii) (a) The Board shall at present comprise of 5 (five) Trustees including the Chairman/Chairperson.
 - (b) There shall not be less than two and not more than 21 (twenty one) Trustees of the Trust at any time.
 - (c) If it gets below this minimum number, the Trustee(s) available will fill it within next 6 months. In this case, even a single trustee can appoint other trustee.
- (iv) The Board of Trustees may, if they think proper, increase or decrease the number of Trustees provided in this clause by passing a Board Resolution on by Three-fourths majority.

(B) Regular Trustees

(i) The Trust shall have a minimum of two and a maximum of 11 (eleven) regular Trustees.

- (i) The Regular Trustees for the time being holding office, may invite outstanding persons from the fields of professions, sciences, arts and academia to become additional Trustees, by two-third majority of Regular Trustees present at the meeting.
- (ii) The Additional Trustees appointed under this sub-clause shall hold office of two years reckoned from the date of appointment or for such other shorter term as the Regular Trustees may determine. Provided that number of such invitee trustees shall not exceed 10 (ten) and provided further that the total number of

Trustee including the Regular Trustee(s) shall not exceed the maximum number stated in clause 8(A)(iii) above.

- (iii) Such an Additional Trustees may also be re-appointed by the Board.
- (iv) Such an Additional Trustee may also be removed by Board in the similar way at any time without giving any notice by passing a Board Resolution.
- (v) Additional Trustees will not have any voting power at Board meetings. However, they will have voting power in subcommittees as per clause 8(I) of this deed. Such trustees may not be called at board meetings of Regular Trustees.

(D) Alternate Trustee

In case a Regular Trustee is absent due to being out of station or unable to serve for a period of more than six months continuously for any reason, then the Regular Trustee(s) may appoint any person as an Alternate Trustee for such period of absence by a Board of Resolution. He will have all the powers and duties of a Regular Trustee during such period, as the absentee Trustee had.

(E) Resignation By Trustee

- (i) A Trustee may retire at any time by giving notice in writing to the Chairman/Chairperson / Board of his / her desire to retire.
- (ii) This retirement will take effect when it is accepted by the board.

(F) <u>Vacation of Office By Trustee</u>

A Trustee will vacate his office in any of the following circumstances automatically:-

(i) On death.

- (ii) Becomes insolvent, after 3 months of such final declaration by Court (after all appeals, if any).
- (iii) Becomes of un-sound mind, as and when so declared by a competent doctor of a Government Hospital.
- (iv) Is convicted of any criminal offence, on the final declaration by Court, after all appeals, if any.
- (v) He / she is not in India for a period of 200 (Two Hundred) days continuously during a financial year, without informing the board in writing.
- (vi) Fails to attend 6 (six) board meetings continuously without taking leave of absence from the board.
- (vii) Any breach of Trust in the working of/ for the Trust.
- (viii) Not working in accordance with the provisions of this Trust Deed.
- (ix) Order of Competent Court / Authority.
- x) If he/she makes any statements or representations to any person or authority against the interests of the Trust or does not follow the rules of the Trust.
- xi) If he/she causes any financial or other loss to the Trust due to his negligence, or acting without authority from the Board in respect of any matter of the Trust.

This will be effective from the date, the Board passes a board resolution for this, after giving a show-cause notice to the concerned trustee and hearing him in the meeting. The concerned trustee may make necessary representations before the board in writing also.

The decision of the Board will be final and binding on the defaulting Trustee for which he will not proceed to any Court of Law. He /She will hand over the charge of his/her office to the other person, as may be required by board. However, he will continue to help the board and the Trust as may be requested by the board at any time.

(G) Qualifications of Regular Trustees

No person shall be eligible to become a Regular Trustee who is below 18 years of age, and who is not endorsed for election by the Settler or Chairman/Chairperson of the Trust or two Regular Trustees. He/she may be elected by a simple majority decision in the Board Meeting.

(H) Chairman/Chairperson

- (i) The Board of Trustees shall have a Chairman/Chairperson. In his/her absence at any meeting, Chairman/Chairperso shall be elected at each meeting who shall be a member of the Board of Trustees to conduct the meeting. Such an election will be made after half an hour of the commencement time of the meeting as given in the notice.
- (ii) Mrs. Bela Kapur shall be the first Chairperson of the Board for the first 3 (three) years.
- (iii) Subsequent Trustees will elect one amongst themselves as the Chairman/ Chairperson of the Trust and such Chairman/ Chairperson shall hold office for a period of three years. However, he/she may resign at any time, but his / her resignation will take effect from the date, when it is accepted by the Board.

(I) Board Meetings

- (iii) At least seven days notice will be given for calling any Board meeting unless decided in advance in the last Board meeting for next meeting. However, the Chairman/ Chairperson may call the meeting by giving even shorter period notice in case of very important and urgent matters.
- (iv) (a) The notice of meeting will state the clear agenda for the meeting and only those matters will be taken up in the meeting.

- Any business which may be necessary for the Board to transact (vii) (except such as is required to be placed before its Annual Meeting), may be transacted by circulation amongst all Trustees and any resolution so circulated and approved by a majority of them shall be as effectual and binding as if such resolution had been passed at a meeting of the Board.

10. Operation of Bank Account

12. Take Over

This Trust may take over any other Trust with similar objects.

13. Dissolution of Trust

The Board may, at a meeting specially convened for the purpose, by unanimously consent decide:

- (i) that the Trust shall be dissolved and thereupon it shall be dissolved forthwith or at time then agreed upon and all necessary steps shall be taken for the disposal and settlement of the property, claims and liabilities of the Trust as the Board shall find expedient; and
- (ii) That if on dissolution of the Trust, there shall remain, after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall be given to some other public charitable institution, trust or body having objects similar to those of the Trust.
- (iii) It is expressly stated that the remaining property as stated in Clause 13(ii) above, shall not in any event be paid to or

His decision will be final and binding on all.


